#### **DECERTIFICATION ORDER**

The Respondent Michael Beaupre has entered into a Decertification Agreement ("Agreement") under which he has agreed to the permanent revocation of his certification (also known as decertification) as a law enforcement officer in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, beginning on the date of approval of the Agreement by the Massachusetts Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission ("Commission"), and the entry of his decertification in the National Decertification Index ("NDI"). See M.G.L. c. 6E, §§ 1, 3(a), , and 10(g); M.G.L. c. 30A, §§ 10 and 13. As further conditions of the Agreement, the Respondent has waived all rights to contest, in this or any other administrative or judicial proceeding to which the Commission is or may be a party, the factual findings, conclusions of law, terms and conditions, and other provisions contained in the Agreement, as well as any Order of the Commission contemplated by the Agreement.

Accordingly, it is hereby <u>ORDERED</u> that, for the reasons stated in the Agreement:

- (a) The factual findings and conclusions of law set forth in the Order to Show Cause in this matter, and incorporated into the Agreement, are hereby adopted;
- (b) The Respondent's law enforcement certification is hereby permanently revoked; and
- (c) The Executive Director shall take the necessary steps to publish the Respondent's decertification in the NDI and any publicly available lists and database published by the Commission.

	The [C]ommission shall have all powers necessary or convenient to carry out and effectuate its purposes, including, but not limited to, the power to: (1) act as the primary civil enforcement agency for violations of [chapter 6E]; (4) deny an application or limit, condition, restrict, revoke or suspend a certification, or fine a person certified for any cause that the [C]ommission deems reasonable; (23) restrict, suspend or revoke certifications issued under [chapter 6E]; (24) conduct adjudicatory proceedings in accordance with chapter 30A;

11. Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 6E, § 10(h), the Commission may institute a disciplinary hearing after an officer's appointing agency has issued a final disposition on the alleged misconduct or one year has elapsed since the incident was reported to the Commission.

12. Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 30A, § 10, "[u]nless otherwise provided by any law, agencies may . . . place on any party the responsibility of requesting a hearing if the agency notifies [the party] in writing of [the party's] right to a hearing and of [the party's] responsibility to request the hearing."

WHEREFORE, the Respondent, Michael Beaupre, is hereby ORDERED to Show Cause why the Commission should not:
